STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) AND (b) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 19 TO BE ANSWERED ON 29th NOVEMBER, 2021 ASKED BY HON'BLE MP SHRIMATI RITA BAHUGUNA JOSHI REGARDING "FUNDS FOR EDUCATION/HRD SCHEMES"

(a) and (b): The details of Schemes/ programmes being implemented by this Ministry at present for facilitating Education/Human Resource Development is given below :

Samagra Shiksha: Samagra Shiksha was launched in 2018-19 for universalization of quality education throughout the country in coordination and consultation with the State and UTs. It is an overarching programme for the school education sector extending from pre-school to class XII and aims to ensure inclusive and equitable quality education at all levels of school education.

The major interventions under the scheme are: (i) Universal Access including Infrastructure Development and Retention; (ii) Gender and Equity; (iii) Inclusive Education; (iv) Quality; (v) Financial support for Teacher Salary; (vi) Digital initiatives; (vii) Entitlements under the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education (RTE) Act, 2009 including uniforms, textbooks etc.; (viii) Pre-school Education; (ix) Vocational Education; (x) Sports and Physical Education; (xi) Strengthening of Teacher Education and Training.

The scheme is covering 11.68 lakh schools, around 15.62 crore students and 57.67 lakh Teachers of Govt. and Aided schools (upto senior secondary level). The State/UT wise details of allocation of funds under Samagra Shiksha scheme is given at Annexure I.

Pradhan Mantri Poshan Shakti Nirman (PM POSHAN): PM POSHAN Scheme is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme covering all school children studying in Balvatika (just before class I) and Classes I-VIII in Government and Government-Aided Schools. The objectives of the PM POSHAN are :

- i. Improving the nutritional status of children studying in classes I – VIII in Government and Government-Aided Schools.
- ii. Encouraging poor children, belonging to disadvantaged sections, to attend school more regularly and help them concentrate on classroom activities.
- iii. Providing nutritional support to children of elementary stage in drought / disaster affected areas during summer vacation.

The State/ UT wise funds allocated under PM POSHAN Scheme for the last three years is at Annexure II and the number of beneficiaries under this scheme is at Annexure III.

National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship Scheme (NMMSS): The 'National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship Scheme' (NMMSS) is a Central Sector Scheme to provide scholarships for meritorious students of classes IX to XII. The objective of the scheme is to award scholarships to meritorious students of economically weaker sections to arrest their drop out at class VIII and encourage them to continue their study and complete secondary stage. The scheme envisages award of one lakh fresh scholarships every year to selected students of class IX and their continuation/renewal in classes X to XII for study in a State Government, Government-aided and Local body schools under the scheme. State and UT wise details of number of scholarship and State-wise funds sanctioned under National Means-Cum-Merit Scholarship Scheme(NMMSS) during last three years (2018-19 to 2020-21) is at Annexure IV.
