Will the Minister of FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING

- (a) whether the Government has announced any steps/schemes/policies in Animal Husbandry towards doubling of farmer's income by 2022;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and budgetary allocation for the same;
- (c) whether the Government has identified any focus areas in achieving the mission of doubling farmer's income across animal husbandry, poultry farming, fisheries and dairying; and
- (d) whether the Government has commissioned any studies to integrate animal husbandry with agriculture for greater synergies for the farmer and if so, the details thereof?

**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. \*233 PART (A) TO (D) FOR ANSWER ON 14.12.2021 ASKED BY SHRI RAJIV PRATAP RUDY, REGARDING “DOUBLING OF FARMER’S INCOME”**

(a) Yes Sir. The Government is implementing various animal husbandry and dairying related schemes to enhance production and productivity of bovines & small ruminants (sheep & goat), piggery & poultry thereby doubling the income of farmers across the country namely:

- i. Rashtriya Gokul Mission(RGM)
- ii. National Programme for Dairy Development (NPDD)
- iii. Dairy Processing and Infrastructure Development Fund(DIDF)
- iv. Supporting Dairy Cooperatives and Farmer Producer Organizations engaged in dairy activities (SDC&FPO)
- v. National Livestock Mission(NLM)
- vi. Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund(AHIDF)
- vii. Livestock Health & Disease Control(LH&DC)
- viii. National Animal Disease Control Programme (NADCP)

(b) The details of budgetary allocation under the various schemes implemented by the Central Government during the last two years and current year are as under:

(c) The Government is implementing the following fisheries, animal husbandry and dairying schemes to enhance production and productivity of fish, bovines & small ruminants (sheep & goat), piggery & poultry in achieving the mission of doubling farmer’s income across animal husbandry, poultry farming, fisheries and dairying. This helps in creating entrepreneurship, direct & indirect employment and better livelihood opportunities for unemployed youth and farmers in cattle, dairy, poultry, sheep, goat, piggery, feed and fodder sector.

- (i). **Rashtriya Gokul Mission(RGM):** For development and conservation of indigenous bovine breeds.
- (ii). **National Programme for Dairy Development (NPDD):** For creating/strengthening of infrastructure for production of quality milk, procurement, processing and marketing of milk and milk products by State Implementing Agency.
- (iii). **Dairy Processing and Infrastructure Development Fund(DIDF):** For creation /modernization /expansion of dairy processing, chilling and value addition infrastructure.
- (iv). **Supporting Dairy Cooperatives and Farmer Producer Organizations engaged in dairy activities (SDC&FPO):** To assist the Dairy Cooperatives and Farmer Producer organisations by providing soft loan for working capital and to provide stable market access to the dairy farmers.
- (v). **National Livestock Mission(NLM):** Entrepreneurship development and breed improvement in poultry, sheep, goat and piggery including feed and fodder development.

- (vi). **Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund(AHIDF):** Incentivizing investments by individual entrepreneurs, private companies, MSME, Farmers Producers Organizations (FPOs) and Section 8 companies to establish (i) dairy processing and value addition infrastructure, (ii) meat processing and value addition infrastructure and (iii) Animal Feed Plant.
- (vii). **Livestock Health & Disease Control(LH&DC):** For control and containment of livestock diseases.
- (viii). **National Animal Disease Control Programme (NADCP):** To control Foot & Mouth Disease (FMD) and Brucellosis and eventual eradication of FMD.
- (ix). **Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY):** For promotion and overall development of Fisheries sector.
- (x). **Fisheries and Aquaculture Infrastructure Development Fund (FIDF):** To assist in creating several infrastructural needs of the fisheries sector in the country.

(d) Indian Council of Agricultural Research, through its Indian Institute of Farming Systems Research, Modipuram under All India Coordinated Research Project on Integrated Farming Systems is undertaking research (on-station research) and technology validation through farmers' participatory research (on-farm research) on crop diversification and integrated farming systems in 25 States/ 1 Union Territory with the participation of State Agricultural Universities, ICAR institutes and Central University. In addition, the Directorate of Poultry Research, Hyderabad is conducting research projects by integrating poultry rearing with agriculture to fetch better income. Also, National Research Centre on Pig has developed Integrated farming module of Piggery with Fish and Agriculture.
