**TARGETS UNDER PMKSY**

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the extent to which the targets fixed under Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY) launched in 2015-16 to enhance physical access of water on the farm and expand cultivable area under assured irrigation have been achieved;
- (b) the details of total amount of funds spent under the said yojana during the last five years, State-wise; and
- (c) the details of the efforts made under the said yojana for prevention of drought?

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**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (c) OF STARRED QUESTION NO. †\*65 TO BE ANSWERED ON 02.12.2021 IN LOK SABHA REGARDING “TARGETS UNDER PMKSY” ASKED BY DR. MANOJ RAJORIA“.**

(a) Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY) is an umbrella scheme, consisting of two major components, namely, Accelerated Irrigation Benefits Programme (AIBP), and Har Khet Ko Pani (HKKP) being implemented by Ministry of Jal Shakti. HKKP, in turn, consists of four sub-components, namely, Command Area Development and Water Management (CAD&WM), Surface Minor Irrigation (SMI), Repair, Renovation and Restoration (RRR) of Water Bodies, and Ground Water (GW) Development component.

In addition, PMKSY also consists of two components being implemented by other Ministries. Per Drop More Crop (PDMC) component is being implemented by Department of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, while Watershed Development component (WDC) of PMKSY is being implemented by Department of Land Resources.

The achievements of various components of PMKSY since 2015-16, are given below.

**PMKSY-AIBP INCLUDING CAD&WM**

After launch of Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana - Accelerated Irrigation Benefits Programme (PMKSY-AIBP) in 2016, ninety-nine (99) on-going major/ medium irrigation projects were prioritized for assured financial assistance, along with their command area development and water management works. Out of these, 46 projects have been completed by the States Governments concerned, while another 21 projects have progress more than 90%. Against a target of 34.64 lakh hectare of additional irrigation, during 2016-2021 an additional potential of 22.74 lakh hectare has been created through these projects. Further, under CAD&WM, against a target of cultivable command area of 50 lakh hectare, 20.68 lakh hectare has been developed during 2015-21.

**PMKSY-HKKP (SMI & RRR of water bodies)**

Under PMKSY, SMI has achieved irrigation potential of 3.44 lakh hectare against a target of 2 lakh hectare. Under RRR of water bodies, achievement during the period is 1.19 lakh hectare, against a target of 1.5 lakh hectare.

**PMKSY-HKKP (GW)**

The ground water component of the scheme was taken up for implementation in May, 2019 after revision of the operational guidelines. An additional area of 35,438 hectare has been brought under irrigation through ground water upto March, 2021.

**PMKSY- PDMC**

An area 57.30 lakh hectare has been covered under micro irrigation through PDMC scheme from 2015-16 to 2020-21.

## **PMKSY- WD**

Against the target of 11.5 lakh hectare, since 2015-16 to 2020-21 about 14.01 lakh hectare of additional area have been brought under protective irrigation.

(b) The details of expenditure made on projects under components of PMKSY are placed at **Annexure**.

(c) PMKSY is targeted towards drought proofing by augmenting irrigation potential and water harvesting. Further, under PMKSY-AIBP and CAD&WM, 59 number of projects specifically benefit drought prone areas, with additional irrigation potential of 20.47 lakh hectare. Out of these, 24 number of projects have been completed, and 13.27 lakh hectare irrigation potential has been achieved.
