**PROMOTION OF AYURVEDA, YOGA AND NATUROPATHY IN JHARKHAND**

**1010. SHRI SANJAY SETH:**

Will the Minister of **AYUSH** be pleased to state:

(a) whether in view of abundant potential of Ayurveda, Yoga and Naturopathy in Jharkhand the Government has formulated or proposes to formulate any scheme to promote the same in the State; and

(b) the details of the works undertaken in this regard by his Ministry in Jharkhand during the last two years along with the expenditure incurred thereon and the number of beneficiaries?

(a) & (b) Ministry of Ayush is implementing the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of the National AYUSH Mission (NAM) through States/UTs including Jharkhand for development and promotion of AYUSH systems including Ayurveda, Yoga and Naturopathy. Under NAM, as per the proposals received from the State Government of Jharkhand through State Annual Action Plan (SAAP), grant-in-aid of Rs. 1522.312 lakhs has been released to them during the last two years for various activities which inter-alia include setting up of up to 50 bedded Integrated AYUSH hospital at Ranchi, establishment of 100 AYUSH Health & Wellness Centres and upgradation of under graduate State Homoeopathic Medical College, Godda.

Further, implementation of the scheme comes under purview of respective State Government and accordingly, as per the information received from the State Government of Jharkhand, they have made expenditure of Rs. 4.56 lakhs only.
