(a) & (b) The Ministry of Health & Family Welfare administers a Centrally Sponsored Scheme namely, 'Establishment of new medical colleges attached with existing district/referral hospitals' under which two medical colleges have been approved in Nagaland. As per the Scheme guidelines, the State Government is the implementing agency and the planning, execution and commissioning of the projects is to be done by the State Government. State Government has been requested to expedite the construction works of the medical colleges. The details of these colleges are as below:-
