Conversion of Feedstock into Fertilizers

1015: SHRI PARTHIBAN S.R. :

Will the Minister of **CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any existing fertilizer plants in the public sector and cooperative sector has converted feedstock plants into fertilizer and dual fuel;
- (b) If so, the details thereof during each of the last three years, State/UT-wise; and
- (c) the details of total cost incurred on conversion of feedstock plants into fertilizers by each plant?

ANSWER

(a) & (b): No existing fertilizer plants in the public sector and cooperative sector has converted feedstock plants into dual fuel. However, during last three years, Madras Fertilizers Limited (MFL)-Manali, a Public Sector Undertaking in Tamil Nadu has converted Feedstock from Naphtha to Natural Gas (RLNG) which was fully commissioned on 28th July, 2019.

(c): Total cost incurred by MFL on conversion of feedstock was Rs.603 Crore.
