# MINISTER OF PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS (SHRI SARBANANDA SONOWAL)

Yamuna river stretching from Jagatpur (6 km upstream of Wazirabad (a) & (b) Barrage) in Delhi to the confluence of the Ganga and Yamuna rivers at Sangam, Prayagraj in the State of Uttar Pradesh for a length of 1089 km has been declared National Waterway-110 (NW-110) by the National Waterways Act, 2016. Detailed Project Report (DPR), the River has not been found viable for cargo movement. River Betwa (NW-19), a tributary of Yamuna in Bundelkhand has been declared a NW for a stretch of 67 Km. As per DPR, the river has not been found viable.
