- (a) No, Sir. It is not true. India has already developed an indigenous Anti-Drone System. The system is capable of Detection, Tracking, Soft Kill and Hard Kill of enemy Drones.
- (b) Not Applicable.
- (c) Information indicates that following countries have Anti-Drone capabilities:
 - USA, Israel, France, UK and Germany.
- (d) & (e) Order for Anti-Drone Systems has been placed by Indian Armed Forces (Navy, Army & Air Force) on M/s BEL based on technology developed by DRDO. DRDO has also transferred the technology for production of these to 04 more private industries.
