- (c) the details of the number of subjects on which research facility is available in the Central University in Jharkhand and the total number of students enrolled therein;
- (d) whether the Government has any plan to expand the Central University in Jharkhand in future; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

- (a) As informed by Central University of Jharkhand, the foreign subjects which are taught in the University are Korean, Chinese and Tibetan language courses.
- (b) Central University of Jharkhand is offering M.Tech and Ph.D programme incorporating skill development courses in 05 (five) Engineering disciplines namely 1. Nanoscience and Technology 2. Energy Engineering 3. Water Engineering and Management 4. Transport Science and Technology and 5. Computer Science and Technology.
- (c) There are 23 subjects on which research facility is available and 118 Ph.D Students are enrolled in Academic year 2020-21.
- (d) & (e): No such proposal is under consideration at present.
