EQUAL PAY FOR EQUAL WORK

1239. SHRI SUBBARAYAN K.:

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of contract workers employed in all the Central Public Sector Undertakings, unit-wise details;**
- (b) whether the contract workers are paid “Equal pay for equal work” in all the CPSUs; and**
- (c) if not, whether the Government would initiate immediate exercise to implement the legal obligation of “equal pay for equal work”?**

ANSWER

**MINISTER OF STATE FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT
(SHRI RAMESWAR TELI)**

(a): The unit-wise details of contract workers in the Central Public Sector Undertaking (CPSU) is maintained by the concerned CPSUs. However, the details of licenses, registration certificates issued and the number of contract workers region-wise is enclosed at the Annexure.

(b) & (c): Under Rule 25 (2) (v) (a) of the Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Central Rules 1971 “equal pay for equal work” is ensured to all the contract workers in the Central sphere by Central Industrial Relations Machinery (CIRM) having country-wide network of Dy. Chief Labour Commissioners (Central) and Regional Labour Commissioners (Central) under the control of the Chief Labour Commissioner (Central)
