**1290. DR. A. CHALLAKUMAR:**

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has achieved the construction of at least one toilet in each school in the country comprising primary, upper primary and secondary levels of education under Swachh Bharat, Swachh Vidyalaya Initiative (SVI);
- (b) if so, the details of total number of toilets constructed so far and number of schools covered, State-wise;
- (c) the district-wise number of schools with dysfunctional toilets along with the total number of toilets in both Government and private categories in Tamil Nadu as on November,2021; and
- (d) the number of toilets constructed, repaired and functional especially in Krishnagiri district, Tamil Nadu during the last three years, year-wise?

**ANSWER

- (a) In response to the announcement made by the Hon'ble Prime Minister on 15 August, 2014, the Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Human Resource Development (now Ministry of Education) had launched Swachh Vidyalaya initiative (SVI) to provide separate toilets for girls and boys in all Government schools, within one year. Under the initiative, the gaps in availability of toilets was addressed and construction/ re-construction of 4,17,796 toilets, including 1.91 lakh girls' toilets, were completed in 2,61,400 Government elementary and secondary schools, as reported by the States and UTs.
- (b) State/ UT-wise total number of school toilets constructed/ re-constructed under Swachh Bharat: Swachh Vidyalaya initiative (SVI) are at Annexure-I.

(c) As per information furnished by the State of Tamil Nadu, 99.38% of Government schools have functional toilets. The district-wise number of Government and private schools having dysfunctional toilets are at Annexure-II.

(d) The State of Tamil Nadu has reported that 7019 toilets are available in 1705 Government schools, 108 toilets have been constructed in last three years and 180 toilets have been repaired during 2019-20 in Krishnagiri district, Tamil Nadu.
