Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to bring amendments to the Air (Prevention and control of Pollution) Act, 1981 to bring "Greenhouse Gases(GHG)" within the definition of "air pollutant";
- (b) whether the Government has not made legislative changes to regulate GHG emissions in spite of its commitment to reduce its emissions;
- (c) whether the Government is planning to enact any new law or amend any existing laws to regulate GHG emissions in the country?
