- (a) & (b): Ministry of Food Processing Industries has undertaken various activities for celebrating and commemorating the 75 years of progressive India and its glorious history as part of the "Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav". There are no Central Public Sector Undertakings (CPSUs) under the Ministry. The details of programmes organized by the Ministry under Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav are as follows:
 - Dandi March Social Media Campaign during the period 12th March, 2021 to 5th April, 2021 Shared information about the successful Food Processing Industries' Projects that are on the route of the Dandi March.
 - Observed "Food Processing Week" during the period from 6th to 12th September, 2021.
 - Inaugurated 21 projects, approved by the Ministry under its various schemes, located in the States of Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Gujarat, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu, and Uttarakhand during the "Food Processing Week".
 - Released ₹ 13.42 crores as seed capital to 4,709 members of SHGs in the States of Assam, Chhattisgarh, Maharashtra, Meghalaya, Odisha, Punjab, Rajasthan, and Uttar Pradesh under the Pradhan Mantri Formalisation of Micro food processing Enterprises (PMFME) Scheme of the Ministry during the "Food Processing Week".
