- (a) whether it is a fact that the country suffers from huge crop loss due to flood every year;
- (b) the details of the extent of agricultural land damaged by floods in the last five years, State/UT-wise and year-wise; and
- (c) the details of the estimated damage to agricultural output as a result of flooding during the said period, State/UT-wise and year-wise?

The estimation in regard to damage to agricultural output etc. is done by the concerned State Governments.
