Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

- (a) the State-wise/Union Territories-wise details of budgetary allocation and its use under BharatNet Project at present;
- (b) whether all the Gram Panchayats of the country have been connected with high speed optical fiber cable network and optical mix of media (means optical fiber cable/radio/satellite) under the BharatNet Project;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) if not, the number of Gram Panchayats of Jammu region;
- (e) whether constituencies of Sonepat and Mangaldoi are currently enjoying this connectivity; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI DEVUSINH CHAUHAN)

- (a) State-wise/Union Territory-wise details of budgetary allocation and its use under BharatNet Project are given in **Annexure-I**.
- (b) & (c) BharatNet project is implemented in a phased manner to provide broadband connectivity to all Gram Panchayats (2.6 lakh approx.) in the country. As on 01.11.2021, a total number of 1,66,088 Gram Panchayats (GPs) are made Service Ready.
- (d) As on 01-11-2021, total 1055 GPs are Service Ready in Jammu & Kashmir (including Jammu Region) under BharatNet Project.
- (e) & (f) Sonipat constituency consists of part of Sonipat District and part of Jind District. As on 01.11.2021, total 638 GPs are Service Ready in Sonipat and Jind Districts and 87 GPs are Service Ready in Mangaldoi constituency.
