Hospitals run by CIL

1644 . SHRI MAHESH SAHOO:

Will the Minister of COAL be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of hospitals being run by Coal India Ltd (CIL) across the country;
- (b) the details of total sanctioned strength of doctors in all the hospitals run by it and the number of existing vacancies particularly in Odisha;
- (c) whether the Government is considering raising the retirement age of doctors in Coal India Hospitals from 60 years to 65 years and bring it at par with the retirement age of doctors across the country;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) if not, the reasons thereof and the time by which a decision in the manner will be taken?

- (a): All total of 70 Hospitals are run by Coal India Ltd (CIL) across the country. In addition to the Hospitals, 358 Dispensaries are also being run by CIL.
- (b): As per the recently approved manpower, the total sanctioned & working strength of Medical Discipline in CIL & its Subsidiaries are 1528 and 981 respectively. The vacancy position of one of the Subsidiaries of CIL located at Odisha (MCL) is 79 (sanctioned is 172 and working is 93).
