Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any proposal for asset monetisation from railway stations in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether any proposal has been sent to Public Private Partnership Approval Committee (PPPAC) for the same; and
- (d) if so, the number of stations and the expected revenue generation from such asset monetization?

- (a) and (b): Yes, Sir. As per National Monetisation Pipeline (NMP) plan prepared by NITI Aayog (August' 21), Ministry of Railways has been assigned to monetise 400 Railway Stations.
- (c) and (d): After the launch of NMP plan, no proposal has been sent to Public Private Partnership Appraisal Committee (PPPAC).
