- (a) The Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) is maintaining centrally protected & monuments in the state of Jharkhand. Following six monuments have been
- (b) identified for special repair works in current financial year.
  - 1. Ancient Temple of Shiva Linga, Khekparta, Dist. West Singhbhum
  - 2. Ancient Tank and remains of temples and structures at Benisagar, Dist. West Singhbhum.
  - 3. Jami Mosque, Hadaf, Dist. Singhbhum
  - 4. Baradari of Mouza Arzimukhimpur, Dist. Sahibganj.
  - 5. Temple at Haradih, Dist. Ranchi
  - 6. Palace and Temple complex, Navaratangarh, Sisai, Dist. Gumla.
- (c) For the financial year 2021-22, Rs.90.0 Lacs has been allotted for the development and maintenance of protected monuments/ sites in the State of Jharkhand.
- (d) There is no protected monuments/ sites in Palamu Dist. of Jharkhand.
