DEVELOPMENT OF ANCIENT PLACES OF PILGRIMAGE IN NANDED

181. SHRI PRATAPRAO PATIL CHIKHLIKAR:

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received any proposals seeking development of ancient places of pilgrimage in Nanded;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the details of action being taken by the Government to develop places of pilgrimage in Nanded district;
- (d) whether various other places including Nanded are likely to be included in the budget 2022-2023 to promote development of tourist places; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a): Sir, no proposal from the State Government of Maharashtra for development of ancient places in Nanded is pending in the Ministry of Tourism.

(b): Does not arise.

(c) to (e): Sir, development and maintenance of the pilgrimage and other tourism places, primarily, is the responsibility of the respective State Government/UT Administration. However, Ministry of Tourism also under its "PRASHAD" and "Swadesh Darshan" Schemes provides Central Finance Assistance for development of such places. The Ministry of Tourism identifies destinations/places and approves projects for development of such places under these schemes, as a continuous process, on the basis of the proposal received from the respective State Government / Union Territory in adherence to the Scheme guidelines.
