STOPPAGE AT MANDI DABAWALI

1830. SHRIMATI SUNITA DUGGAL:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Railways has received requests for stoppage of Jammu-Tawi-Jodhpur Express at Mandi Dabawali;**
- (b) if so, the details thereof;**
- (c) whether the Railways has planned to provide six months experimental stoppage at Mandi Dabawali; and**
- (d) if so, the guidelines for the stoppage of different class of trains?**

(a) to (d) Demands, including that from the Hon'ble Member of Parliament, have been received for provision of stoppage of 19225/26 Jammu Tawi-Jodhpur Express at Mandi Dabwali. These have been examined but found operationally not expedient, at present. However, provision of stoppages in existing train services is an ongoing process on Indian Railways subject to operational feasibility and commercial justification.
