FUNDS FOR ANDHRA PRADESH UNDER JJM

1888. SHRI MARGANI BHARAT:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of funds allocated, released and spent under Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) in the State of Andhra Pradesh since implementation of the mission;
- (b) the details of targets set and achieved in Andhra Pradesh under JJM;
- (c) the details of rural households which are yet to be provided with tap water connection in Andhra Pradesh, district-wise; and
- (d) the time by which the above households are going to be provided with tap connection?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR JAL SHAKTI (SHRI PRAHLAD SINGH PATEL)

(a) Year-wise details of the funds allocated, drawn by the Government of Andhra Pradesh and reported expenditure, since the launch of Jal Jeevan Mission, is at **Annex–I.**

(b) to (d) Since August, 2019, Government of India in partnership with States, is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM), to make provision of potable tap water supply to every rural household in the country by 2024.

In August, 2019, at the time of announcement of the Jal Jeevan Mission, out of 95.17 lakhs rural households in Andhra Pradesh, 30.74 lakhs (32.31%) rural household were reported to have tap water connection. Since then, 18.43 lakhs rural households have been provided tap water connections. Thus, as on 06.12.2021, provision of tap water supply has become available to 49.17 lakhs (51.67%)rural households and 46 lakhs households remains to be provided tap water connection in the State. The district-wise detail is at **Annex–II**.
