CONSTRUCTION OF SHELTER FOR URBAN HOMELESS

NO. 1895: SHRIMATI SUNITA DUGGAL:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the funds released to construct shelters for urban homeless in Haryana during the last three years along with the details of schemes under which the said funds have been released;**
- (b) whether the Government has set any target under the said scheme;**
- (c) if so, the details thereof during the last three years, year-wise and the success achieved thereunder; and**
- (d) whether the shelters to be given to urban homeless are being upgraded and if so, the details thereof?**

- (a) Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs is administering a scheme “Shelter for Urban Homeless (SUH)”, as a component of Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana – National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM), through respective States/Union Territories. In this Mission, funds are allocated to States/ UTs in a consolidated manner. Out of this, appropriate amount is apportioned by States/UTs for different components of Mission including SUH, as per their requirements. During 2018-19, no funds were released to Haryana. During 2019-20 and 2020-21, ₹ 29.63 Crore and ₹ 10.54 Crore respectively were released to the State for DAY-NULM.**
- (b)&(c) Cumulatively during the last three financial years, Haryana had planned to establish 44 shelters; out of these 26 shelters have been already made functional.**
- (d): States / UTs have been directed to provide basic amenities in shelters which include ventilated rooms, lighting, kitchen, separate toilets for male and female, drinking water and storage space etc.**
