FOUR-LANING WORK ON ALLAHABAD-LUCKNOW NH

1952. SHRIMATI KESHARI DEVI PATEL:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to carry out four-laning work of Allahabad-Lucknow via Raebareli National Highway;**
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the time by which the said work is likely to be completed;**
- (c) whether the Government has allocated budget for this project and if so, the details thereof; and**
- (d) whether No Objection Certificate has been obtained from all the concerned departments for this project and if so, the details thereof?**

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

(a) to (d) The work of construction of 4-lane bypasses at Jagatpur, Babuganj, Unchahar, Alapur, Link road to NH-19, Sai River Bridge and work of 4-lane of 8.5 km stretch from Km 180.2 to Km 188.7 of Allahabad (Prayagraj) to Raebareli stretch, are at present in bidding stage. The tentative cost of these works is Rs. 1,150 crore with completion period of 2 to 2.5 years from date of start. Ministry declares appointed date of projects after obtaining all required clearances from concerned departments. The stretch from Raebareli to Lucknow has already been 4-laned.
