- (a) whether the Government is making efforts for commercial extraction of methane hydrate deposits in Krishna-Godavari basin and Mahanadi- Andaman basin which has potential to make India energy independent;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

- (a) & (b): Yes Sir. Gas hydrate exploration in India is steered by the Ministry of Petroleum & Natural Gas under National Gas Hydrate Program (NGHP). Till date, two expeditions, the first in 2006 (NGHP-01) and the second in 2015 (NGHP-02) have been undertaken under National Gas Hydrate Program. Under NGHP-01, 39 holes were drilled to explore the presence of gas hydrate at 21 sites in Krishna-Godavari (KG), Mahanadi, Andaman, and Kerala-Konkan Basin. Under NGHP-02, 42 holes were drilled at 25 sites in KG and Mahanadi Basin.
