REVIEW OF ONGOING/PENDING PROJECTS

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has decided to review ongoing/pending projects under Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) in the country particularly in Maharashtra and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the total number of such projects sanctioned and pending in the State as on date;
- (c) whether the Government is aware that the various projects are pending due to non-sanction of bank loans in Maharashtra; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the steps being taken by Government to review such projects with Maharashtra and the concerned banks?

(a) & (b): Ministry of MSME has a robust system of monitoring and reviewing its schemes. These are on real time and online/offline basis spread over the entire financial year. In the State of Maharashtra, the Ministry of MSME runs several schemes, the details of, which are as below:
