## CONTRIBUTION OF SMALL AND MEDIUM INDUSTRIES IN MANUFACTURING SECTOR

2006. SHRI AJAY NISHAD:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Small and Medium Industries play an important role in the manufacturing sector of the country;
- (b) if so, the percent-wise contribution of small and medium industries in the total production of manufacturing sector during the year 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21;
- (c) whether certain units of Small and Medium Industries have been closed also during the aforesaid period; and
- (d) if so, the number of units closed during respective years of the aforesaid period and the reasons therefor?

#### **ANSWER**

# MINISTER OF MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (SHRI NARAYAN RANE)

- (a) & (b): Yes, Sir. The contribution of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises' (MSME) manufacturing Gross Value Added (GVA) in all India manufacturing GVA (at current prices 2011-12) during 2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20 was 40.38 %, 40.38 % and 40.40 % respectively.
- (c) & (d): As MSMEs are present both in formal and informal sector, data regarding units closed during respective years of the aforesaid period are not maintained in this office.
