**Will the Minister of POWER

- (a) whether the Government has received proposals from the State of Madhya Pradesh regarding power supply in small villages and hamlets;**
- (b) if so, the details along with the present status thereof;**
- (c) if not, the schemes of the Government in this regard;**
- (d) the target fixed and achieved at present under each and every scheme launched by the Union Government to provide electricity to farmers of each villages and households in the country including Madhya Pradesh during the last three years and the current year; and**
- (e) the funds allocated and utilised under the said schemes during the said Period?**

**(a) to (e) : Supply/distribution of electricity to consumers is undertaken by the respective State Governments and/or State Power Utilities. All the States and Union Territories (UTs) including Madhya Pradesh have signed MoUs with the Central Government to ensure 24x7 power supply to all households, industrial & commercial consumers and adequate supply of power to agricultural consumers w.e.f. 1st April 2019 onwards. Government of India assists the States through its various schemes including Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Gram Jyoti Yojana (DDUGJY), Integrated Power Distribution Scheme (IPDS) and Ujjwal Discom Assurance Yojana (UDAY) to enable them to achieve the objective of providing uninterrupted power supply to all households.**

**Under Saubhagya scheme, as on 31.03.2021 all the States have reported 100% electrification of all the willing un-electrified households, identified before 31.03.2019. As reported by the States, 2.817 crore households have been electrified upto 31.03.2021 since the launch of Saubhagya. The State/UT-wise details of household electrification including Madhya Pradesh are at Annexure-I.**

**Under DDUGJY, Saubhagya and IPDS, funds are released against the sanctioned projects in installments based on the utilisation of amount released earlier and fulfillment of stipulated conditions. Total Grant of Rs.28,176 crore, Rs.4,193 crore and Rs.16,153 crore have been disbursed to the States during the last three years and current year (up to November,2021) under DDUGJY, Saubhagya and IPDS, respectively. The State-wise details are given at Annexure-II, Annexure-III and Annexure-IV respectively.**

**Saubhagya scheme was closed on 31.3.2019. The State of Madhya Pradesh reported 100% electrification of all the willing un-electrified households in the State as on 31.3.2019. Further, the State of Madhya Pradesh has informed that 2,82,514 un-electrified households have been identified post 31.3.2019.**

**In August, 2021, the average availability of power in the rural areas was 21.09 hours, and in urban areas it was 23.41 hours. The State-wise details of power supply in the rural areas and urban areas including Madhya Pradesh, for the last three years and current year is at Annexure-V.**
