STRIKE BY STAFF OF SPICEJET

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION

be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether the Government is aware of the strike called by the Employees of Spicejet Airlines;**
- (b) if so, the details thereof;**
- (c) whether the Government collects advance information about such issues in private airlines to prevent closure of airlines and the loss to the Banks and the public thereby; and**
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?**

ANSWER

(a) and (b): The Airline has informed that there had not been any strike called by employees of Spicejet. However, there have been a few instances of protest by staff at some places / stations.

(c) & (d): Each airline prepares its business plan on the basis of their own market assessment and liabilities. Based on their business plan, the efficient operations and financial resources are the responsibility of the Airlines.
