- (d) the details of other steps taken by the Government to improve the availability of all the petroleum products across the country?

(a) to (d) As on 01.11.2021, there are 305 Oil Terminals/Depots in the country. The installation of new Oil Terminals/Depots is a continuous process depending upon the requirement of a particular region including fulfillment of statutory norms and commercial viability. Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) have informed that 14 new Oil Terminals/Depots are under construction in the country which includes one each in Karnataka and Bihar. Presently, availability of petroleum products is sufficient to meet the full market demand of the country.
