COVID-19 VACCINATION IN ODISHA

2106. SHRI JUAL ORAM:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the salient features of the vaccine being used to combat the COVID-19 in Odisha;
- (b) the number of districts covered so far within Odisha under the vaccination process; and
- (c) The steps being taken by the Government to cover remote/inaccessible areas under the mission in Odisha?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

(a) to (c) National COVID-19 Vaccination Programme is ongoing across all States/UTs covering all the districts including Odisha since 16th January 2021. Presently, three vaccines are administered under National COVID-19 Vaccination Programme after approval from the National Regulator i.e. Central Drugs Standard Control Organization (CDSCO). These are (i) Covishield manufactured by M/s Serum Institute of India Pvt., Ltd., Pune, used at both Government & Private CVCs (ii) Covaxin: manufactured by M/s Bharat Biotech International Limited, Hyderabad, used at both Government & Private CVCs and (iii) Sputnik V: imported by M/s Dr. Reddy's Laboratories Ltd, Hyderabad, used at Private CVCs.

COVID-19 Vaccines Operational Guidelines, provides guidance for organizing session at remote areas for lesser number of beneficiaries ensuring no vaccine wastage, provision of special mobile vaccination teams and Near to Home Vaccination Centers. Further, from 3rd November 2021, "Har Ghar Dastak Abhiyan" has been launched wherein missed beneficiaries for 1st dose and due beneficiaries for 2nd dose are identified and vaccinated through house to house activity across the country including Odisha.
