- (a) to (f): Medical Counseling Committee (MCC) of Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS) is the allotment authority entrusted by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India to conduct counseling for All India Quota/ Deemed/ Central Universities seats of Under Graduate courses (MBBS/ BDS) as per the scheme devised by the Hon'ble Court for the following Quotas:
 - i. 15% All India Quota seats contributed by the states/ UTs
 - ii. 100% seats of Central Institutes/ Universities (AMU, BHU, Delhi University, Jamia Milia Islamia, ESIC)

- iii. 100% seats of Deemed Universities
- iv. 100% seats of AIIMS Institutes across India & JIPMER (Puducherry & Karaikal)

88120 MBBS seats and 27498 BDS seats are available in both Government and Private colleges.

The counseling for NEET-UG, 2021 has been postponed pending decision in the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
