There are 29 vacant posts of Accountant Members and 28 vacant posts of Judicial Members in the Income Tax Appellate Tribunal (ITAT). In respect of these vacancies 22 recommendation of names have been approved for appointment and offers have been issued to all recommended 22 candidates.

The selection process to fill up the vacant posts of Members, Chairperson in Tribunals is a continuous process and the same has been initiated for the vacant post of Members in CESTAT and vacant posts of Chairperson and Members in Appellate Tribunal (SAFEMA).
