**FREE COVID-19 VACCINATION BENEFICIARIES**

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of free vaccine administered to prevent COVID-19 across the country till date;
- (b) the number of persons likely to be benefitted as a result of free COVID-19 vaccination; and
- (c) the number of first and the second dose of the vaccine administered, State/UT-wise along with the details in terms of population ratio?

(a) to (c) The COVID-19 vaccine is available free of cost for all citizens of the country aged 18 years and above irrespective of their socio-economic status at all Government COVID-19 Vaccination Centres (CVCs). As per data of vaccination coverage at Government and Private CVCs are available from 1st May 2021 to 5<sup>th</sup> December 2021, a total of 107.86 crore doses (96%) of COVID-19 Vaccine have been administered at Government CVCs free of cost.

As on 6<sup>th</sup> December 2021, a total of 80.02 crore (85.2%) adult population aged 18 years and above have received first dose of COVID-19 vaccine and 47.91 crore (51.0%) have received both the doses. The State/UT-wise details are at Annexure-1.
