**COVID-19 VACCINATION IN HIMACHAL PRADESH**

**2212. SHRI SURESH KUMAR KASHYAP:**

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the first dose of COVID-19 vaccine has been administered to all the eligible persons in Himachal Pradesh;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the number of vaccines provided by the Government free-of-cost to Himachal Pradesh so far including the total cost of these vaccines; and
- (d) the time by which the second dose of COVID-19 vaccine is likely to be administered to the eligible people in Himachal Pradesh?

(a) to (d) As on 7<sup>th</sup> December 2021, a total of 58,39,664 estimated eligible beneficiaries aged 18 years & above received COVID-19 vaccines 1<sup>st</sup> dose in Covid Vaccination Centers (CVCs) in Himachal Pradesh as per information available in CoWIN portal.

A total of 1,10,67,650 doses of COVID-19 vaccine has been supplied to Himachal Pradesh under free supply from Government of India since inception of vaccination program till 7<sup>th</sup> December 2021. Adequate quantity of vaccine doses have been made available to all States/UTs to vaccinate all eligible 1<sup>st</sup> dose and due 2<sup>nd</sup> dose beneficiaries aged 18 years and above.

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
