FUNDS ALLOCATION TO MOTI LAL NEHRU MEDICAL COLLEGE, PRAYAGRAJ

2222. SHRIMATI KESHARI DEVI PATEL:

Will the MINISTER OF HEALTH & FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) the funds allocated to Moti Lal Nehru Medical College, Prayagraj during each of the last five years and the heads under which the said funds have been spent along with the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has received any complaints regarding the quality of the development works in the said college;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the action taken on the said complaints along with the outcome thereon; and
- (d) whether the Government proposes to build a separate hospital/block for treatment of cancer in Moti Lal Nehru Medical College and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

(a): Upgradation of Moti Lal Nehru Medical College, Prayagraj, through construction of Super Specialty Block (SSB), was undertaken under the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY), at an approved outlay of Rs.150 crore (Central share-Rs.120 crore and State's share-Rs.30 crore). The upgradation project was implemented through implementing agencies selected for the purpose and funds were released to these agencies and not to Moti Lal Nehru Medical College, Prayagraj. The civil work of the project has been completed and the details of central funds released for this project are as under:-

In addition, under Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) for upgradation of existing State/Central Government Medical Colleges for increasing MBBS seats, proposal for increasing 50 MBBS seats has been approved at Motilal Nehru Medical College, Prayagraj at a cost of Rs. 60 crores and entire Central Share of Rs. 36 crores has been released to the State Government (Rs. 24.20 crores in 2019-20 and Rs. 11.80 crores in 2020-21). Further, under Phase – I of CSS for Strengthening and up-gradation of State Government Medical Colleges for starting new PG disciplines and increasing PG seats, proposal for increasing 24 PG seats has been approved at Motilal Nehru Medical College, Prayagraj at a cost of Rs. 4.05 crores and entire Central Share of Rs. 3.03 crores has been released to the State Government (Rs. 1.31 crores in 2009-10 and Rs. 1.72 crores in 2012-13). As per the CSS guidelines, the State Government is the implementing agency and the planning, execution and commissioning of the project is done by the State Government.

- (b) & (c): No such complaints have been received in this Ministry.
- (d): Department of Surgical Oncology is approved in the new Super Specialty Block at MLN Medical College, Prayagraj under the PMSSY for treatment of cancer.
