**CHILDREN HOSPITAL IN BUNDELKHAND, UTTAR PRADESH**

**2231: SHRI R.K. SINGH PATEL:**

Will the **MINISTER of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any 200 bedded children hospital has been constructed in Banda and Chitrakoot districts of Bundelkhand region in Uttar Pradesh;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the time by which these hospitals are likely to be made functional?

(a) to (c): As per the information received from the Government of Uttar Pradesh, Banda and Chitrakoot districts of Bundelkhand region have not constructed any 200 bedded Government facility for children. The services for children are provided at Special Newborn Care Units (SNCUs) and Nutrition Rehabilitation Centres (NRCs) at District Hospitals in both the districts. In addition, Newborn Stabilization Units (NBSUs) have been established at sub-district level in Banda and Chitrakoot districts of Bundelkhand region.
