Will the Minister of CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS be pleased to state:

- (a) Whether the Government proposes for establishing Central Institute of Petrochemicals Engineering and Technology (CIPET) in various States including Deoghar District of Jharkhand;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the steps taken/being taken by the Government for its speedy completion?

ANSWER

MINISTER FOR CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS (DR. MANSUKH MANDAVIYA)

(a) & (b) Govt. of India has approved establishment of 15 New CIPET Centres in various states across the country including one at Ranchi (Jharkhand) during XII Five Year Plan in the years 2015 & 2016 and the status of its establishment, are as under:

In addition to the above, Govt. of India is in the process of establishing CIPET Centres at Ayodhya (Uttar Pradesh), Navsari (Gujarat) and Sanand (Gujarat) with financial support from the State Government as per the Model II Guidelines for establishment of new CIPET Centre. Further there is no proposal for establishment of CIPET Centre at Deoghar District of Jharkhand.

(c) The progress of Establishment of New CIPET Centres are being reviewed regularly by the Governing Council of CIPET, chaired by the Secretary (C&PC) & President, Governing Council of CIPET. The State Government, also, monitors the progress through Regional Advisory Committee (RAC), for speedy completion of the project in the respective states.
