Leakage of Question Papers

†2382. SHRI LALLU SINGH:

Will the Minister of **EDUCATION** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has taken note of incidents of leakage of question paper of National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET) and Joint Entrance Examination (JEE) conducted this year;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the steps taken or proposed to be taken by the Government to stop the recurrence of such incidents in the future?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (DR. SUBHAS SARKAR)

(a) to (c): The Government has established National Testing Agency (NTA) as an autonomous and self-sustained premier testing organization to conduct entrance examinations for higher educational institutions in the Country. As per records of the NTA, there are no incidents of leakage of question paper of NEET (UG) and JEE (Main) conducted so far by NTA.
