(a) The details of expenditure incurred for maintenance and conservation of protected monuments in Bihar including excavated remains at Nalanda during last five years are as under (approx. in lakh Rs):

- (b) ASI carried out excavation at the site of Rukministhan, district Nalanda (Bihar) during field season 2014-15 and 2015-16. The excavations revealed two phases of occupation affiliated
- to Gupta and Pala period. Besides, important structural findings include a small monastic complex, temple platform and votive stupa complex around the temple, *kirtimukha*, two statues of Buddha along with antiquarian materials such as beads, dices, gamesmen, stamps, sealing, amulet, mould, dabber, plaque, animal and human figurines, ear-lobe, spool, etc.
