(a) & (b): Ministry of Tourism under the schemes of "Swadesh Darshan", "National Mission on Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD)" and 'Assistance to Central Agencies for Tourism Infrastructure Development' provides financial assistance to State Governments/Union Territory Administration/Central Agencies for development of tourism infrastructure in the country, including Rajasthan, in consultation with them. Details of projects sanctioned under the Swadesh Darshan, PRASHAD and Assistance to Central Agencies Schemes in the State of Rajasthan for development of tourism related infrastructure is given at Annexure.

(c): Ministry of Tourism, promotes India in a holistic manner, including Rajasthan and as part of its on-going activities, it releases global print, electronic and online media campaigns in important and potential markets overseas, under the 'Incredible India' brandline, to promote various tourism destinations and products of the country. Promotions are also undertaken through the website (www.incredibleindia.org) and Social Media accounts of the Ministry. The promotions are undertaken through the "Domestic Promotion and Publicity including Hospitality Scheme" (DPPH) and "Overseas Promotion and Publicity including Market Development Assistance" (OPMD) Schemes of Ministry of Tourism.
