**Kendriya Vidyalayas in Maharashtra**

**†2525. SHRIMATI BHAVANA PUNDALIKRAO GAWALI:**

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Kendriya Vidyalayas being run by the Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan at present in Maharashtra, district-wise;
- (b) the number of new Kendriya Vidyalayas constructed and opened during the last three years across the country State-wise including Maharashtra;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to open new KVs in tribal dominated areas and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to include any new scheme, on the lines of Kendriya Vidyalayas in rural areas under the New Education Policy with the consultation of State Governments; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

**ANSWER**

**MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION  
(SMT. ANNPURNA DEVI)**

- (a) Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS) has informed that at present 59 Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) are functioning in the State of Maharashtra. District-wise details are at **Annexure-I**.
- (b) The State / UT-wise details of KVs opened / constructed during the last three years are at **Annexure-II**.
- (c) Opening of new KVs is a continuous process. KVs are opened primarily to cater to the educational needs of the wards of transferable Central Government Employees including Defence & Para-Military personnel, Central Autonomous Bodies, Central Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) and Central Institute of Higher Learning (IHL) by providing a common programme of education. Proposals for

opening of new KVs are considered only if sponsored by Ministries or Departments of the Government of India / State Governments / Union Territories (UTs) Administrations and committing resources for setting up a new KV. The proposals received from various sponsoring authorities found fulfilling the mandatory pre-requisites for opening of new KVs have to compete with other such proposals under the “Challenge Method” and subject to approval of the competent authority. KVs are not opened on the basis of State / UT / districts / area-wise.

(d) & (e) There is no such new scheme at present to open schools in rural areas on the lines of KVs. However, the Finance Minister in Budget Speech on 01.02.2021 has announced to qualitatively strengthen more than 15,000 schools from across the country to include all components of the National Education Policy, 2020. The objective is to develop them as exemplar schools in their regions, handholding and mentoring other schools to achieve the ideals of the policy. Moreover, the existing Navodaya Vidyalaya Scheme envisages opening of one Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya in each district of the country to provide good quality modern education to the talented children predominantly from the rural areas.
