(a) to (c): The Country has a rich cooperative heritage and a robust cooperative sector which has been greatly contributing to the national economy as well as boosting the productivity in various sectors, especially agricultural sector. The percentage share of cooperatives in national economy in certain key sectors has been as follows:

Fertilizer production: 28.80% Sugar production: 30.60% Liquid Milk Marketing: 84.17% Wheat Procurement: 13.3% Paddy Procurement: 20.4%
