TRANSIT CAMPS IN NORTH-EAST REGION

2559. SHRI ASADUDDIN OWAISI:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is planning to build any transit camps in the North-East region in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the reason for changing the name of detention centres to "transit camps";
- (d) whether the Government has maintained any data on the number of people lodged in such detention centres; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI NITYANAND RAI)

(a) to (e): State Governments/ Union Territory (UT) Administrations are delegated the powers and functions to make necessary arrangements (including the naming) for detention centres/ camps as per their requirement. State Govt./UT Administration set up such centre/camp as per Model Detention Centre/Holding Centre/Camp Manual 2019. No data in respect of such Centres/Camps is maintained centrally.
