Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is successfully implementing Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY) in the country especially in North Eastern Region and Jhansi and Lalitpur of Uttar Pradesh (UP);
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the amount of funds allocated and utilized by the Government under the said yojana during each of the last three years and current year;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to provide remunerative employment to the rural population in UP, particularly from Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe category of North Eastern Region, through skill training programmes conducted under the said Yojana; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

(a) & (b) The Deen Dayal Upadhayaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY) is being implemented in North-Eastern States and Jhansi & Lalitpur Districts of Uttar Pradesh since September, 2014. It is a placement linked skill development program for rural poor youth in the age group of 15-35 years. DDU-GKY guidelines provide for earmarking 50% of the funds for SCs and STs and 15% for minorities. Further, one third beneficiaries of the respective categories under the scheme should be women.

DDU-GKY follows a 3-tier implementation architecture for implementation. National level is responsible for policy, funding of central share and technical support, while State Rural Livelihood Missions (SRLMs)/ State Skills Missions are responsible for funding of State share, implementation and monitoring controls. Project Implementing Agencies (PIAs), which are mostly private training partners, are responsible for mobilization, training and placements. The details of progress in North-Eastern Region and Jhansi and Lalitpur districts of Uttar Pradesh is given at **Annexure-I**.

(c) As DDU-GKY is a demand driven schemes, hence there is no State-wise allocation of funds under the scheme, however State-wise funds release status as on 30.11.2021 for North-Eastern region and the State of Uttar Pradesh is given as under:
