#### **BENEFICIARIES OF MSP**

2654. SHRI S.VENKATESAN:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS' WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) the percentage of farmers who got Minimum Support Price (MSP) in the last five years, crop-wise for 23 commodities for which MSP is announced; and
- (b) the percentage of crop production which got MSP in the last five years, crop-wise?

#### **ANSWER**

(a) & (b): Government implements Price Support Scheme (PSS) for procurement of pulses and oilseeds as and when proposals are received from the State Governments as per the scheme Guidelines. All the proposals received from States have been sanctioned immediately and there are no pending proposals at present. Government also undertakes procurement of paddy and wheat at MSP from farmers through Food Corporation of India (FCI) and State Agencies. Further, different types of nutri-cereals and maize are procured at MSP from farmers by State Governments itself in consultation with FCI to the extent that the concerned State Government may utilise the same for distribution under Targeted Public Distribution System (TPDS) as well as Other Welfare Schemes (OWS). Further, due to the announcement of Minimum Support Price (MSP) by the Government & procurement operations, the overall market also responds which results in private procurement on or above the MSP. Hence, It is very difficult to assess the exact number of farmers benefitted under MSP operation. However, the details of farmers benefitted under Government procurement operation at MSP & percentage of procurement to production at MSP cropwise, since 2016-17 at Annexure-I.
