Will the Minister of FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Pradhan Mantri Formalisation of Micro Food Processing Enterprises(PMFME) scheme launched under Atmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyan is working to enhance the competitiveness of existing individual micro-enterprises in the unorganized segment of the food processing industry and promote formalization of the sector;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the details of the efforts being made in the various districts of Uttar Pradesh under the said scheme in this regard?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES (SHRI PRAHLAD SINGH PATEL)

(a): Yes

(b): Ministry of Food Processing Industries is implementing a Centrally Sponsored "PM Formalisation of Micro food processing Enterprises (PMFME) Scheme" for providing financial, technical and business support for upgradation of micro food processing enterprises in the country. Support to upgrade existing units or setting up of new micro units for individuals is provided through a credit linked grants-in-aid @35% up to a maximum grant of Rs. 10.00 lakh. The Scheme also provides support to food processing units of SHGs/ FPOs/ Cooperatives for credit linked grants-in-aid @35%, Seed Capital to SHGs, Incubation Centre, Common Infrastructure, Marketing & Branding and Capacity Building.

The Scheme has adopted One District One Product (ODOP) approach to reap the benefit of scale in terms of procurement of inputs, availing common services and marketing of products. ODOP for the scheme provides the framework for value chain development and alignment of support infrastructure.

(c): The Ministry has released Central share of Rs.37.99 crore to State of Uttar Pradesh till date for implementation of scheme. Further, the following steps have been taken by the Ministry in the State of Uttar Pradesh:

(i). One District One Product (ODOP) for 75 districts of Uttar Pradesh have been approved. The list of approved ODOP is at **Annexure**.

(ii). 10 Incubation Centers have been approved in the districts of Agra, Aligarh, Ayodhya, Bareilly, Basti, Gorakhpur, Jhansi, Lucknow, Meerut and Varanasi with an outlay of Rs.33.26 crore.

(iii). Rs.1.70 crore has been disbursed as seed capital to 645 Self Help Group (SHG) members.

(iv). State Level Technical Institute has been approved for the State and 27 Master Trainers have been trained on EDP and various food domains.
