PURCHASE FOR BUFFER STOCK

2771. SHRI GURJEET SINGH AUJLA:

Will the Minister of CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION उपभोक्ता मामले, खाद्य और सार्वजनिक वितरण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Union Government has purchased produce from farmers at the same price during lockdown to maintain the buffer stock and if so, the details thereof; and
- (b) the alterations made in prices at which farm produce was bought from farmers to store in buffer at every stage of lockdown in 2020?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT AND CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD & PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

(a): Wheat and paddy has been procured at Minimum Support Price (MSP) for central pool smoothly in 2020 and 2021 including lockdown period. A quantity of 389.92 LMT and 433.44 LMT of wheat was procured in RMS 2020-21 and RMS 2021-22 respectively. The quantum of paddy procured under central pool during KMS 2019-20, KMS 2020-21 was 770.93 LMT and 894.18 LMT respectively.

During lockdown, the stock of wheat and rice was sufficient to maintain buffer stock, in-fact it was surplus.

(b): No alternations made in price during lockdown period. Procurement of wheat and paddy for central pool were made at MSP announced by Government of India.
