LOSS OF SUBSCRIBER BASE

2863. SHRI VELUSAMY P.:

Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received any report from Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited (BSNL) regarding the loss of subscriber base for the last financial year;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with specific number of loss of subscribers, State-wise with break up figure of wireless and wireline services;
- (c) the steps taken by the Government to increase the subscriber base;
- (d) the amount spent by BSNL for upgradation of their services for the past three years and the estimated amount for the current year; and
- (e) whether the Government is having any proposal to merge BSNL and MTNL and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI DEVUSINH CHAUHAN)

- (a) & (b) The details of landline and mobile connections of BSNL during the last two years are at **Annexure-I.**
- (c) BSNL augments its network based on techno-commercial considerations. It has rationalized its tariff plans and tied up with different channel partners to improve the services and increase its subscriber base. The Government on 23.10.2019 approved the revival plan of BSNL which inter-alia includes administrative allotment of spectrum for 4G services through capital infusion by the Government into BSNL/MTNL. BSNL is in the process of deployment of indigenous 4G technology through Proof of Concept route under Atma-nirbhar initiative of the Government of India.
- (d) The details of expenditure by BSNL for upgradation of their mobile services for the past three years and the estimated amount for the current year are as follows:

(e) The Government earlier in its cabinet meeting dated 23.10.2019 approved in-principle approval for merger of BSNL and MTNL. However due to financial reasons including high debt of MTNL, the merger of MTNL with BSNL is deferred. However, close co-operation and service integration between BSNL and MTNL has been undertaken.
