**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 2956 BY SHRI GIRISH CHANDRA AND SHRI PARTHIBAN S.R. TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 15.12.2021 REGARDING DECREASE IN REVENUE GENERATION**

**(a) and (b): Yes, Sir. In 2020-21, Railways' Total Traffic Revenue decreased by ₹ 34,145 crore compared to the previous year 2019-20. This was mainly on account of decrease in passenger and other coaching revenue by ₹ 35,421 crore and ₹ 2,544 crore respectively compared to previous year. This decrease was partly offset by increase in Freight and Sundry Other Revenues. Details are as follow:**
