BharatNet project is implemented in a phased manner to provide broadband connectivity to all the Gram Panchayats (GPs) in the country through an optimal mix of media (Optical Fibre Cable/Radio/Satellite). As on 30.11.2021, 2,298 GPs are Service Ready in West Bengal, including 154 GPs of Purulia Parliamentary Constituency.

The infrastructure created under BharatNet project is a national asset, accessible on a non-discriminatory basis to the Service Providers, and the same can be utilized to provide internet services to the citizens.
